Acceptable Forms of Transportation

You will receive sedation for your procedure. The medications we will administer to you are **Fentanyl** and **Versed**.

Fentanyl is a narcotic and is given to reduce any discomfort you may have during the procedure.

Versed is a sedative that will help you to sleep. Some people feel dizzy and become forgetful after this medication is administered. This is a normal side effect.

Because you will be receiving sedation, it is very important that you have a responsible adult (**family member or friend**) drive you home. It is also important that you have a responsible adult with you at your home. **You CANNOT go home by BUS or TROLLEY** even if you have someone to assist you. **It is ONLY acceptable to take a TAXI if you have your responsible adult with you.**

If you cannot find a ride home, please make arrangements with a **medical** transportation service.

Please note: We cannot give you sedation without the above mentioned form of transportation.
